FOR THE TREATMENT OF ACTINOBACILLOSIS AND AS AN AID IN THE TREATMENT OF
ACTINOMYCOSIS AND DERMATOMYCOSIS IN CATTLE

PRESENTATION: Solution (injectable): 100mL

ACTIVE CONSTITUENTS: Each mL contains: Sodium Iodide 500mg

PROPERTIES:

SODIDE™ is for the treatment of actinobacillosis and as an aid in the treatment of actinomycosis and dermatomycosis in cattle. The precise mechanism of action of sodium iodide in systemic fungal disease is unknown. Sodium iodide aids in the resolution of granulomatous lesions in actinobacillosis, actinomycosis and various fungal diseases.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: This product is contraindicated for use in pregnant or hyperthyroid animals. If toxic signs such as excessive lacrimation, dyspnoea, tachycardia or exfoliation of the skin occur treatment should be discontinued immediately.

This product may be given intravenously only by, or under supervision of, a veterinary surgeon.

Cattle: 40mL/300kg bodyweight diluted in 60mL *Water for Injections BP* by slow intravenous infusion or subcutaneous injection. Treatment may be repeated twice at 10-day intervals if required

WITHHOLDING PERIOD: **Meat:** DO NOT USE less than 28 days before slaughter for human consumption.

Milk: Milk collected 10 days following treatment MUST NOT BE USED for human consumption or processing. This milk should not be fed to bobby calves.

TRADE ADVICE: EXPORT SLAUGHTER INTERVAL (ESI): This product does not have an ESI established. For advice on the ESI contact the manufacturer on (02) 9672 7944 before using this product.

POISONS SCHEDULE: Nil.

IN-USE BROACHING: Discard unused portion after three months of first broaching container.
